(New) libraries should be designed to cater to the changing and unforeseeable needs of both faculty and students, allowing them to read in company; to sit at long tables or individually; to be able to discuss their reading experience or read in silence; to browse (perhaps changing) core collections online as well as in the open stacks; to help faculty and students scan works whose copyright has been cleared by library staff; to make specific (and preferably free) educational resources available, and so on. The new library should be a light-filled flexible space, easily reconfigurable, but also emanating the conviction of permanence: the permanent importance of turning information into constructive knowledge, and suitable for the multiple tasks related to the book, the text, information, data, reading and interpretation.
